

Florida Judges Gemstone Award Program

Monitoring of point accumulation will be on the Honor System using a Gemstone Activity Form. Each activity should be signed by an individual who is able to verify the completion of the activity. Verification of forms submitted to the SJD will be conducted by the FL NAWGJ Professionalism and Ethics Chair and reviewed by NAWGJ Board. Points carry forward from year to year until you reach the diamond level.

Judges Cup Volunteer	Up to 13 hours per day for actual hours on site
<u>NAWGJ Board Member</u> Based on workload considered to be "continuous"; "periodic" or "as needed/requested"	SJD, Assigner, Treasurer: 30 hours Newsletter Editor, Secretary, CPE Coordinator: 20 hours All other positions: 15 hours
Volunteer (unpaid) at regional, national, elite meets, collegiate meets	Up to 10 hours per day for actual hours on site
Serve as assigned mentor to new judge (assignments made by the Mentorship Chair)	2 hours per year
Attend judging clinics beyond those required for CPE (clinics geared solely toward recreational gymnastics, cheerleading, coaching will not apply toward this credit). This activity is intended to promote clinics specifically designed to improve competence as a judge.	NAWGJ National Symposium = up to 8 hours per day Brevet or National Course = up to 8 hours per day Level 10 Re-certification Course = up to 8 hours per day NAWGJ State Clinic = up to 8 hours per day All others = up to 8 hours per day Note: only sessions at USAG congress addressing women's artistic gymnastics judging apply for Gemstone.
Prepare and present a clinic/workshop approved by SJD or assigned by USAG State Clinic Director or Regional/National USAG Program Directors	Up to 8 hours per clinic session for preparation work
Practice judge with judge at higher level judge (in-gym or video). Brevet judges may practice with same level. This is actual practice judging rather than in-gym observation or coaching; SJD must be notified in advance. Both the judge who is practice judging as well as the higher rated judge may count points towards Gemstone.	Up to 8 hours per year
Special activity assignment for FL-NAWGJ, e.g., Judges Cookbook or similar item approved by NAWGJ Board	Up to 8 hours per year
Coordinate/conduct a fund raiser for FL NAWGJ, e.g. silent auction at Judges Cup; Aloha Grams at Judges Cup. Events to be approved by NAWGJ Board.	Up to 8 hours for preparation time per event.
Critique judge at Optional Critique Meet (as part of paid assignment)	2 hours per day
Volunteer as Additional Critiquer at Critique Meet (unpaid volunteer)	Up to 10 hours per day for actual time spent critiquing
Attending Training Camp (8/9, or 9,10, elite only). If clinic is held, you can get points for time spent on the floor that is not part of the clinic. You may also earn points for time spent in the clinic. Don't double count though.	Up to 10 hours per day for actual time spent in gym. Clinicians/station coordinators may report an additional 4 hours if they are working at a station at the request of state or regional USAG or NAWGJ Board members.
