Unusual Judging Situations

Beam: gymnast mounts with hands on board front walkover to sit. While coming up to the sit, her feet are supported on the board on the other side of the beam, what do you do? This would be a fall! Deduct 0.05.

Floor: Gymnast performs RO, FF 2/1 twist-FHS Front layout, front layout, FHS Front layout, front tuck. Are there any deductions? Yes. The 3rd front layout would receive a) and the gymnast would not have a "B" dismount.

Floor: gymnast performs front salto, RO, FF 2/1 twist-FHS, front salto tuck Front salto tuck, RO, FF 2/1 twist. Are there any deductions? Yes. No "B" dismount because of the same pass.

Beam: FF swing down (Korbut) to Silivas. Does this get CV? No. The Silivas is a roll and not dance or acro.
